


### Electricity traded on Day-Ahead Market at IEX touches a new high

The electricity traded on Day Ahead Market at IEX, touched a new high on Sunday, 8 September, 2013 with the highest ever trade of 117 MUs. The traded volume recorded was 105% higher than the corresponding day last year.

The increased trade quantum can be attributed to the rise in electricity requirement from the distribution companies in western and northern parts of the country. Of the total traded volume of 117 MUs, distribution companies (Discoms) accounted for almost 60 % of the total buy volume while the remaining 40% was through Open Access consumers. Sale bids of over 150 MUs were clocked on the day. The traded volume could have been even higher had it not been for the congestion in the inter-state transmission network.



### CERC issues judgement on REC eligibility of waste-to-power project in Delhi

The Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC) has given partial respite to Timarpur-Okhla Waste Management Company which has been struggling to secure registration of its 16 MW waste-to-power project under the Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) scheme.

The company operates a single unit of 16 MW power generating station in Delhi and had secured accreditation for two projects of capacity 8 MW each in early February 2012. The company has a power purchase agreement with distribution company BSES Rajdhani Power Limited for 8 MW capacity and sells the balance power through open access mode.

The National Load Dispatch Centre (NLDC) raised objection on several issues and has so far refused to grant the certificate of registration to the projects. The NLDC objected to the practice by the company to apply for accreditation of two projects even though it operates a single unit of 16 MW. The CERC has ruled in favour of the company on this issue.

The Commission also directed the NLDC to issue the certificate of registration to the 8 MW under the open access mode within 15 days of the issuance of the order.
